4.1 Transporting the Game

If you need to move the game, adjust the levelers back to an “up” position.



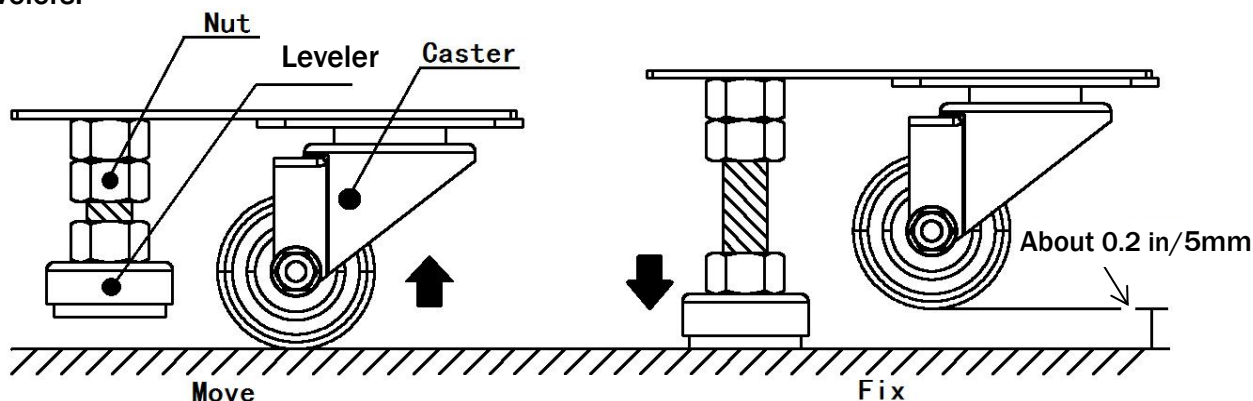

4.2 Level Adjustment

Install this game on a flat surface. If the game is installed on an unsuitable floor, it could cause game malfunction.

To secure the game, loosen the nut, utilize wrench to adjust the leveler down until it touches the floor, lifting the casters off the ground by 0.2 in/5mm. Repeat the same for all levelers.

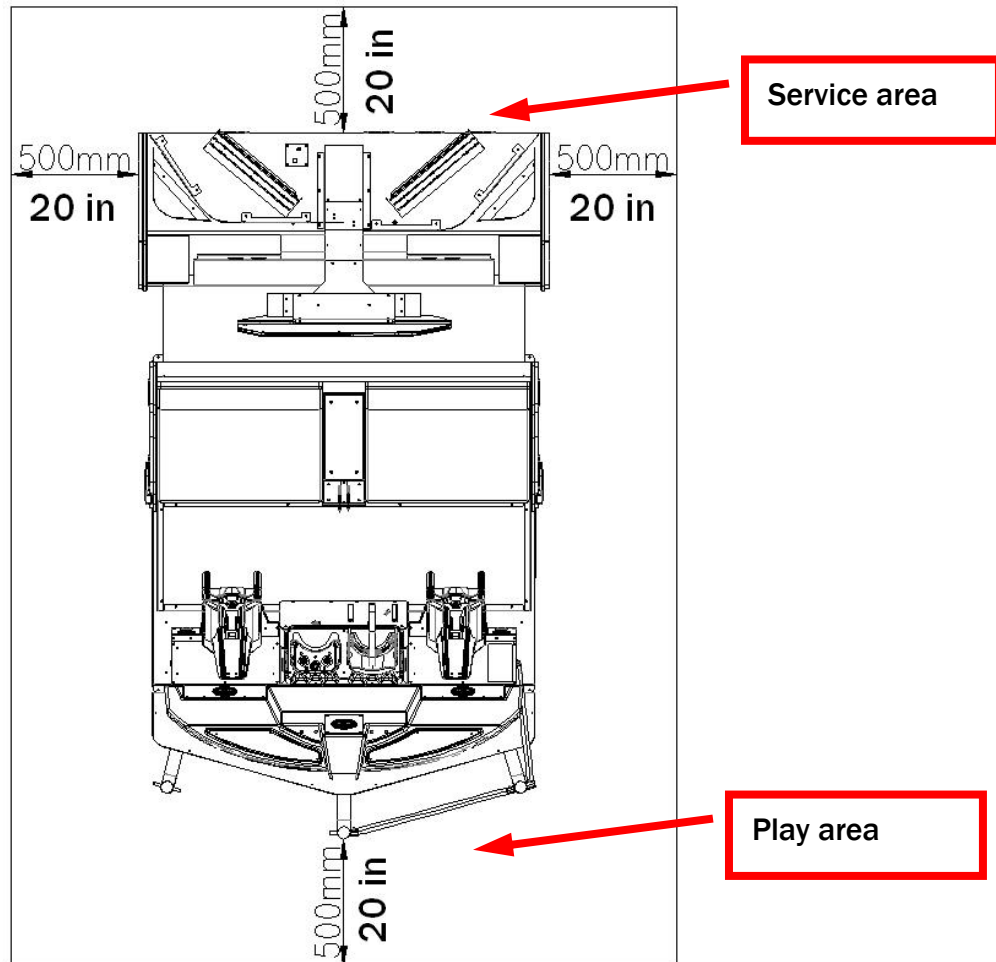

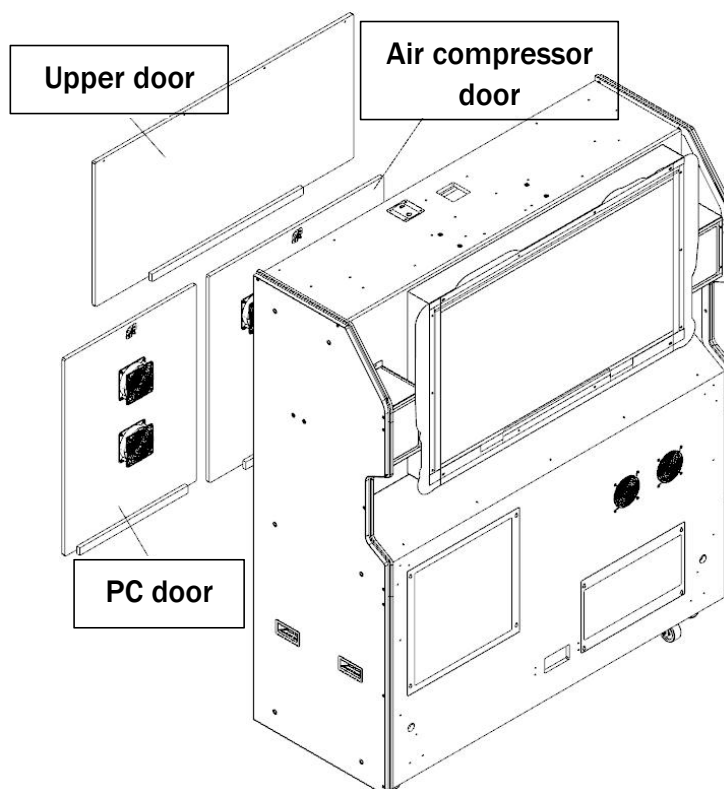

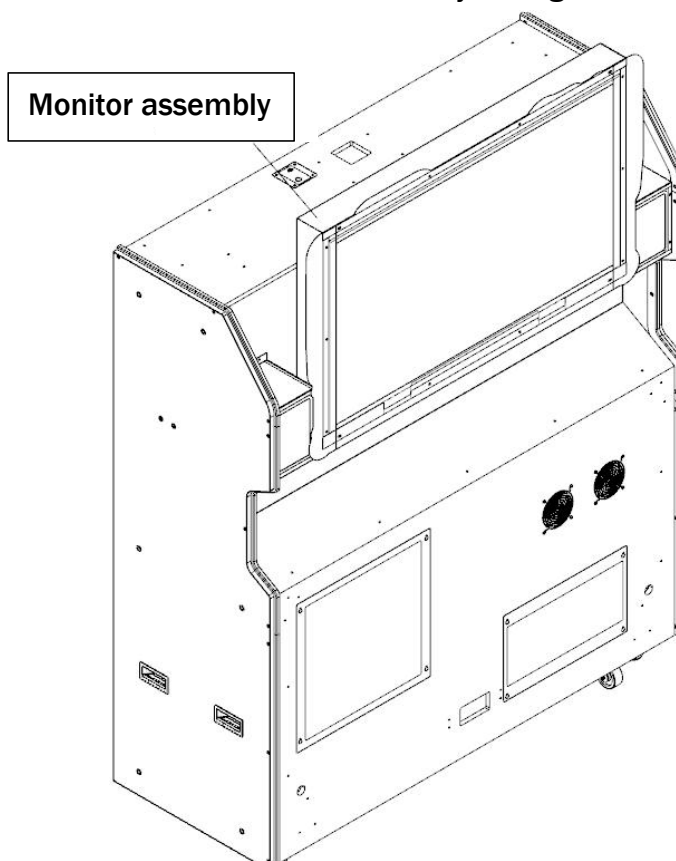
4.4 Machine Installation

Step 1 To facilitate subsequent installation,utilize key and loosen screws to remove 3 back doors.

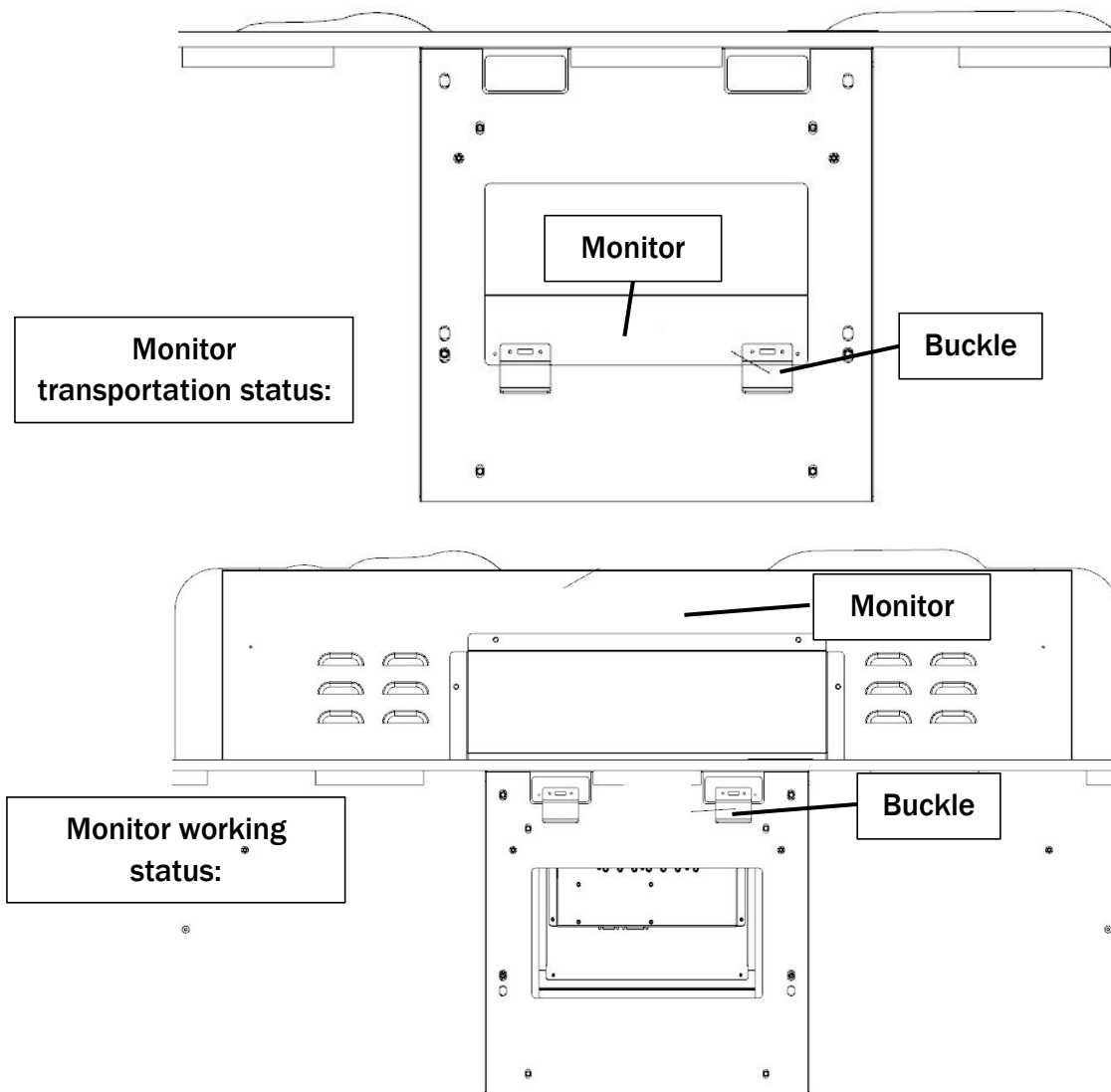


Step 2-1 Loosen Monitor fixing screws on the cabinet inside. Lift the Monitor up to the upper buckle.

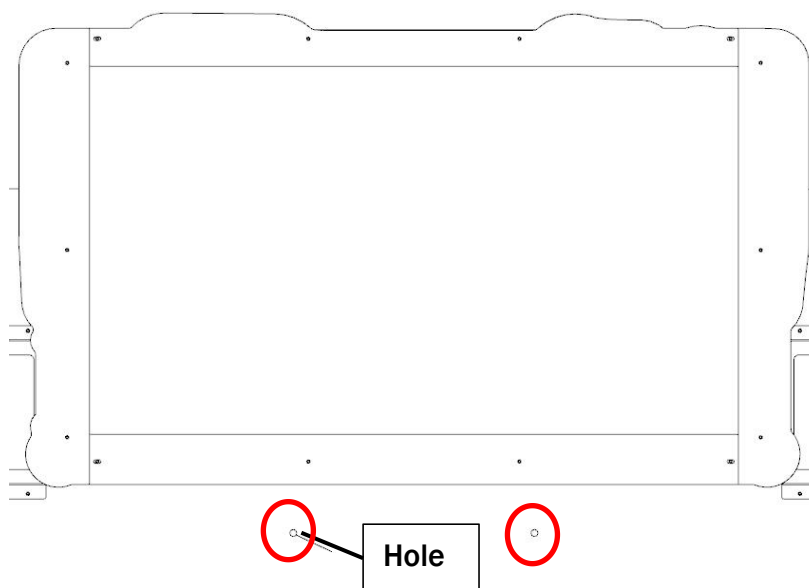
Notice: Staffs need to hold the Monitor assembly during the installation.



Step 2-2 Secure the screws and connect the connectors and cables after lifting monitor finish.



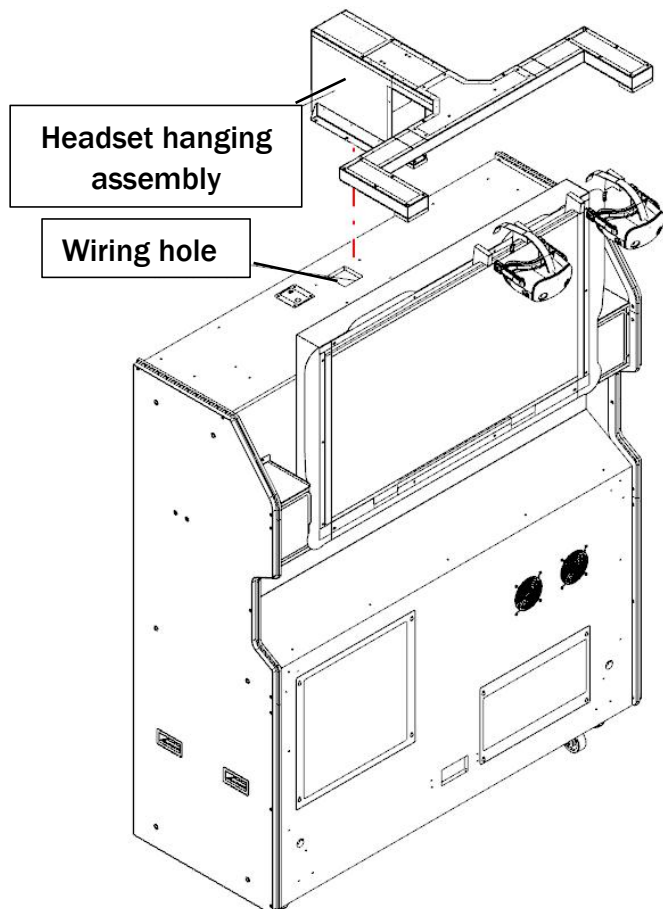
Step 2-3 Insert hole cover to the position as shown below for covering the hole.



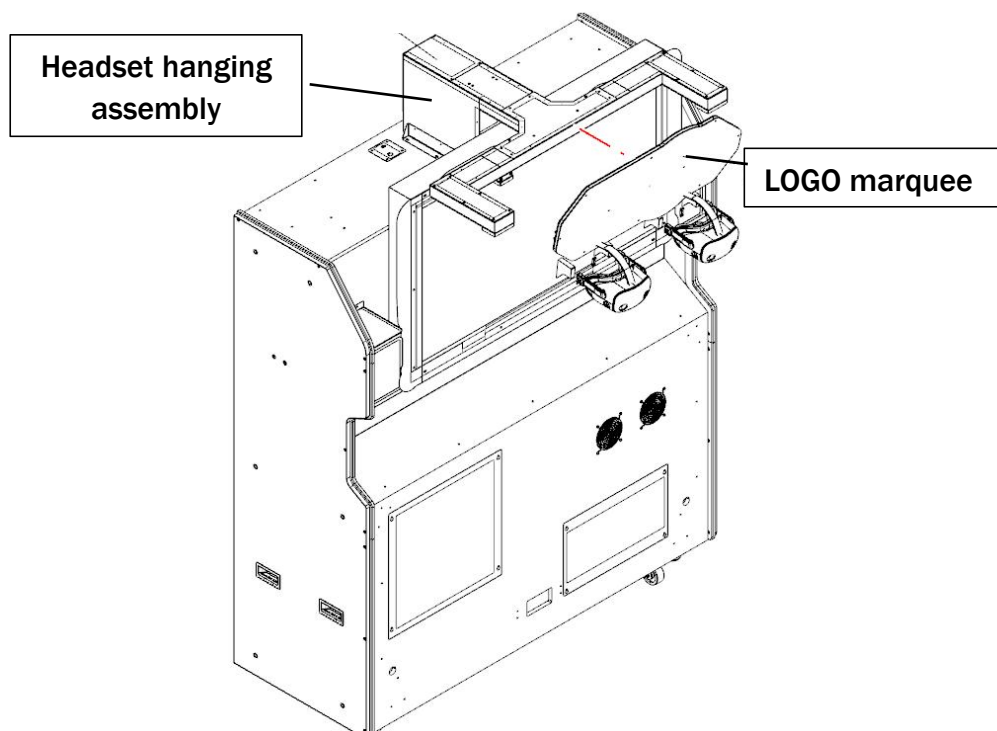
Step 3-1 Install Headset hanging assembly. Route the connectors to the PC through the Wiring hole. Connect the Headset connectors to the PC.

Step 3-2 Utilize screws to secure the Headset hanging assembly.

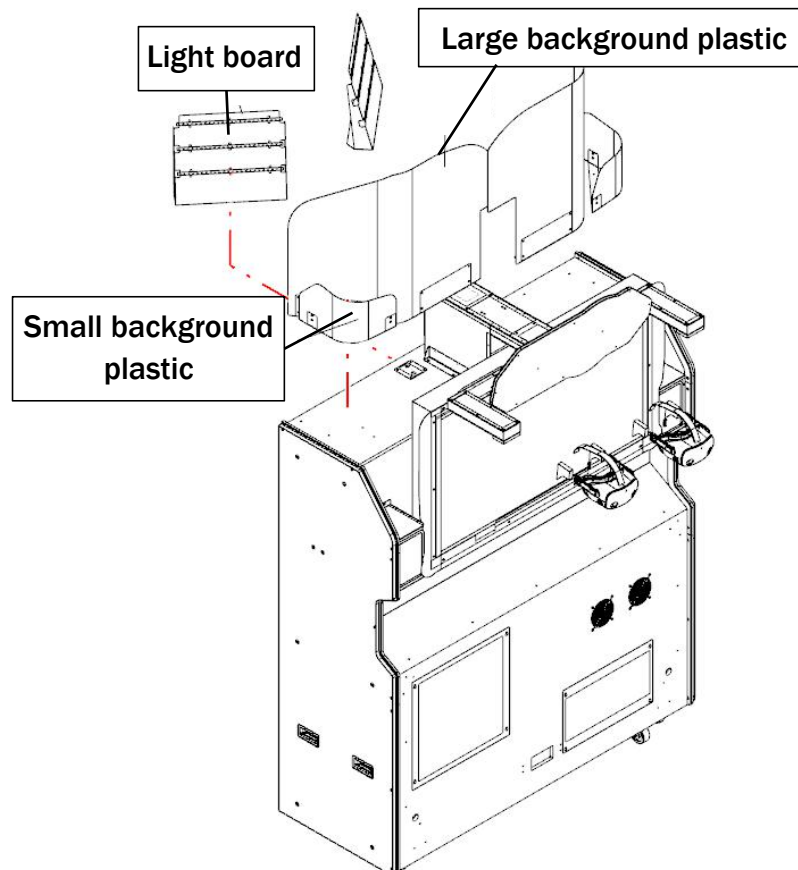

Step 15 Install Front fence assembly. Fasten the hooks to the buckle on both sides of Console.

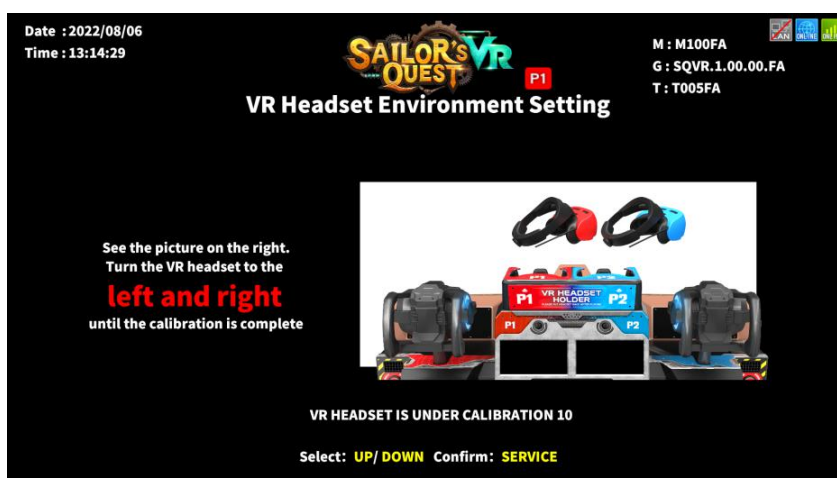


Step 16 Power on the machine. Open the Coin door, and press the **【TEST】** button to enter **【Main Menu】** as shown below.

4.5 Card Reader Installation Safety Notice



Take precaution to assure that all wiring voltages are confirmed prior to installation of card reader. All warranties are void if not properly installed resulting in logic board damage.

Important: This game is pre-wired to AAMA standards. It is highly recommended to utilize this wiring for Card reader installation.

4.6 How To Wear The VR Headset

1. Turn the knob on the back of the VR Headset in the counterclockwise direction to loosen the head strap.



2. Hold the VR Headset on both sides and place it over the player's eyes, allowing the VR Headset to surround the player's eyes. If the player is shortsighted, it is recommended to wear glasses while playing.



3. Make slight vertical adjustments the VR Headset position until the image is clear.



4. Pull down the head strap on the back and tighten the head strap for a comfortable fit.



5. Turn the knob to the right to tighten so that the VR Headset will not move about when the player moves his/her head; however, do not make it too tight as it will cause discomfort around the player's eyes.



4.7 Precautions for Powering Machine On

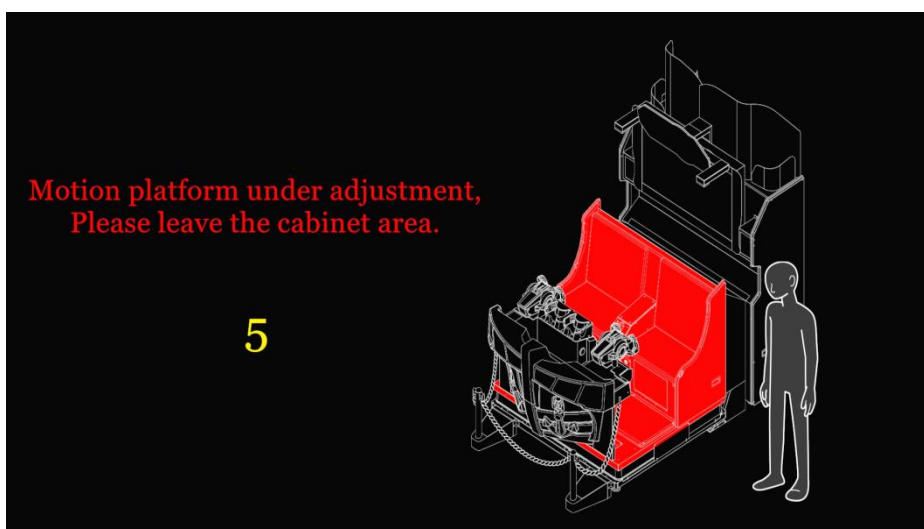
To ensure the successful calibration of the Motion platform and the VR Headset, please follow the instructions below to power on the machine:

Step 1 Use the key to open the storage door and take out the VR Headset.。

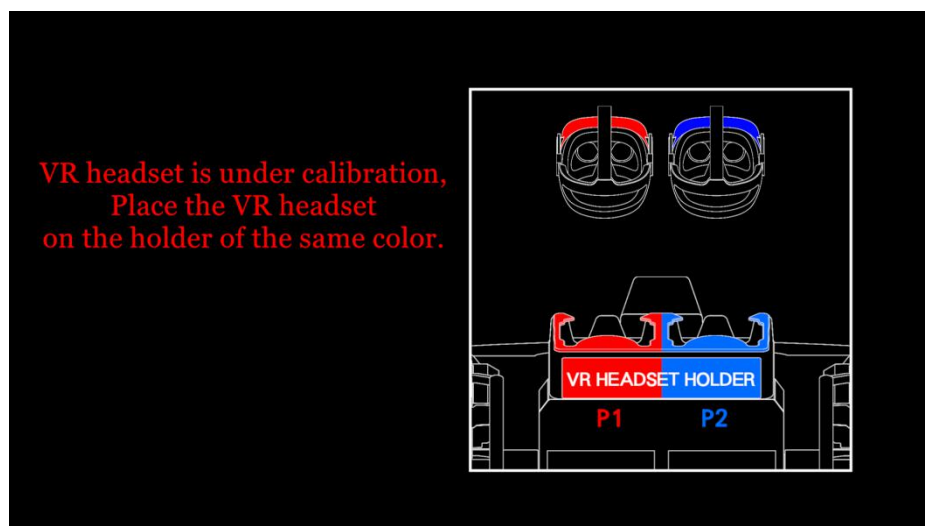
Step 2 Place the VR Headset on the VR stand and power on the machine.

Step 3 When powering on the cabinet:

1. If the text **【Motion platform under adjustment, Please leave the cabinet area.】** is displayed on the screen, please leave the cabinet and platform.



2. If the screen shows [VR headset is under calibration, Place the VR headset on the holder of the same color.], please place the VR Headset on the VR stand with the corresponding color for calibration.



3. If the icon **【Sensor Function Off】** is displayed at the bottom left of the screen, press the **【Emergency】** button in front of the vehicle body to cancel the emergency stop function to complete the calibration of the Air Spring.



4.8 Precautions for Powering Machine Off

When Power off the machine, please follow the instructions below:

1. Please ensure that the game is in idle status and no player is sitting on the cabinet.
2. Power off the power supply and air compressor on the back of the cabinet.
3. Place the VR Headset on the VR stand in front.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Common Problem

Please confirm that all connectors fit tightly.

Symptom	Possible Cause	Recommended action
Game will not start	Frame assembly connector is loose.	Check connector.
	Frame assembly fault	Contact with UNIS Service.
